

**TOWN OF PRIMROSE
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
ROAD INSPECTION – APRIL 27, 2009**

MINUTES

Call to order at 9:30 a.m. Members present chairman Dale Judd, Supervisors Dave Garfoot, Alex Elkins, and patrolman Bruce Stamm.

1st stop: Peerless Road where a new culvert was installed last fall. There was a complaint from an adjacent land owner that water was running into his field. Inspection showed that patrolman had graded the bank and field so that water is not running into the field. Water is running in the ditch to a non-cropped area.

2nd Area of Viewing: Ridge Road Bids will be accepted for sealcoating starting at Hwy. U going West to at least Primrose Center Road. Sealcoating will also be done on Ridge Rd. starting at Hwy. G going east to an area between Brunner's and Sponem's driveway. Rationale: This area of Ridge Drive can be slippery in winter. Sealcoating will provide extra traction. NOTE: The black top area in front of Primrose Church may also be sealcoated. Cost to be paid by the church.

Total length approximately 2.8 miles. A portion of Ridge Road may not be sealcoated depending on total cost.

3rd Area of Viewing: Bids will be accepted for double sealcoating Miller Rd. from Hwy U to Fire No. 8475. Approximate length .2 mile. NOTE: The base of this road has been prepared by patrolman the last 2 years for double sealcoating this portion of road.

4th Area of viewing: Bridge on old JG. A sidewall on this bridge needs reinforcement. Patrolman will work to have boulders placed next to wall as a way to shore up its strength.

5th area of viewing: Culvert on Britt Valley Rd. near Virgil Haag's farm. A portion of culvert on North side of road needs to be replaced. Patrolman said he can do this work, but will need to hire a backhoe because of the steepness of the bank.
